

CUSTOMIZED WORKFORCE TRAINING DOLLARS

Colorado's job training programs invest in the state's labor force and incentivize business growth by providing grants to Colorado companies locating or expanding in the state, or upgrading the skills of current employees to remain competitive in the global market.

Funding up to \$1,400 per employee is available to local employers through the **Colorado First and Existing Industry training programs**. Submit a simple application prepared with the assistance of community college staff to help formulate a customized training plan driven by employer needs and timeline.

FUNDING SNAPSHOT

Eligible Employees

- Permanent – Non-Seasonal
- Full-time (at least 32 hours/week)
- Must earn at least minimum wage for rural areas

Employer Requirements

- All Industries accepted (except retail)
- Non-Profit Agencies 501(c)(3) may submit applications
- Small companies eligible to apply
- Multiple employer grant possible

Training Providers

- **Community College** – customized workforce development divisions
- **Other Training Providers** – employers may select specialized training providers for customized skill development
- **Employer Subject Matter Expert** – internal training provider may be approved

IMPORTANT DATES

Applications may be submitted between **July 1, 2019 – March 31, 2020**. Financials should be submitted two weeks prior to application. Awards are contingent upon available funding and determined two weeks after application submission. All training must be completed by **May 31, 2020**.
