

The business park study was completed in April of 2016 and found that much of our demand for new industrial and office space could be met by increasing density in our existing business parks. The study recommended creating a makerspace to foster new entrepreneurs in the region. The Alliance helped fund the Makerlab housed at the Powerhouse Science Center in Durango.

The Airport


Despite the loss of the airport expansion, the Alliance helped raise over \$100,000 and committed significant volunteer time to advance the ballot initiative. The Alliance continues to work on finding options for fixing the problems at our current air terminal and finding better flight access to other cities .

High Speed Internet

The high speed wireless internet that the Alliance helped fund expanded rapidly in southern La Plata County. By the end of 2016, almost 2,700 homes had access to high speed internet for the first time or saw significant upgrades to their existing speeds. These homes now have access up to 50 Mbps of internet (more than twice the FCC's definition of high speed internet).



AlignTec is now delivering up to 50 mbps to nearly 2,700 homes in La Plata County.




Alliance Staff Time Allocation, 2017
